"So Quiet...You Won't Believe It's On!"

Replacing Halogen Light Bulb with G4 LED Bulbs

Note: The halogen light used in these images is 12 volts/ 20 watts, G4 base.



Steps:

- 1. Make sure all controls are off and range hood is unplugged.
- 2. If preferred, remove the halogen light fixture from the hood body. Otherwise, the halogen light fixture can be left on the hood body.
- 3. Using a flat head screw driver, gently remove the halogen light glass cover as seen in figure 2.
- 4. Gently pull out the defective light bulb and discard as seen in figure 5.
- 5. Put the new light bulb in by pushing securely into the light socket (action similar to figure 5).
- 6. Return halogen light glass cover to the housing.
- 7. Turn range hood ON to test for operation.

Important Notes:

- Before purchasing a replacement bulb, check the volts/watts of your current halogen light.
- For the bulb type, Kobe uses **JC-Type**, **G4 base**, **Halogen Lights**.
- G4 Halogen Lights may be replaced with G4 base LED Lights.
